



Location:

Where is LA PIERRE VERTE located?

The campsite is located at 6 km from the town centre of Fréjus, and 8 km from the beaches of Fréjus, at the heart of nature. To get there: take motorway A8 exit n° 38 (Fréjus centre-ville). After the toll booths, follow the direction of « Bagnols en Forêt », the campsite is located at 3 km to your right, near a roundabout.

If you drive on the N7 or the seafront, you can still follow « Bagnols en forêt ». You'll find a Décathlon store on your left. Continue straight on for 5 km. The campsite is located just after the military basis 21 RIMA, to your right, near a roundabout.

Distance to the supermarket?

On site, you'll find a grocery store open 7 days per week (PROXI market), with fresh bread and pastries every morning. Not far from the campsite, you'll find two supermarkets: Carrefour at 5 km, towards Puget-sur-Argens and Géant Casino at 5 km towards Saint-Aygulf. You'll also find Lidl and Leader Price shops at about 3 km from the campsite.

Distance to the train station?

The train station of Fréjus is located at 6 km from the campsite. This is a small train station, and therefore we recommend you to stop at the train station of Saint-Raphaël, at 10 km from the campsite, as this train station offers a bus service (1 or 1bis will take you directly to the campsite). Please note: this is only possible in **July** and **August**, in low season you'll need to change buses in the town centre of Fréjus.

You can also take a taxi opposite the train station of Saint-Raphaël (approx. price 35/40€).

Distance to the airport?

The airport of Nice-Côte d'Azur is located at 60 km (including 52 km of motorway) from the campsite, or about 45 minute drive. There is a regular bus service between the airport and the town centre of Fréjus.

Bus to town?

A bus to town stops at 200 m from the campsite entrance. In low season, you'll find several timeslots per day (every 3 hours) and you need to change buses in the town centre of Fréjus, to go to the beach or to Saint-Raphaël. In high season (July and August), more buses stop near the campsite (every two hours). This bus is practical as it will take you to the town centre of Fréjus, the seafront of Fréjus Saint-Raphaël and the train station of Saint-Raphaël.

Bus to the beaches in July and August?

La Pierre Verte offers you a free shuttle to the beaches and Aqualand; from Monday to Friday it leaves in the morning at about 10.30 am and returns at about 4.30 pm.

Beaches: sand or pebbles?

In Fréjus the beaches are fine sand beaches, just like the main beach of Saint-Aygulf. Pebble beaches and creeks may be found in Saint-Raphaël (10 km from the campsite).

Beaches allowed for dogs?

Only the Esclamandes beach in Saint-Aygulf is allowed for dogs (about 10 km). It is located just after the Aqualand leisure park, towards Saint-Aygulf.

Regional markets?

Fréjus offers a market in the centre of town on Wednesday and Saturday mornings as well as a market at the seafront. Nighttime market at the seafront in July and August.

Campsite:

Opening dates?

Camping La Pierre Verte welcomes you from Saturday 02 April to Saturday 24 September 2016. From the opening, all facilities and services will be open 7 days per week: shop, bar, restaurant, take away, snack bar, water park with heated pool of 15 x 15 and heated paddling pool. Reduced activity programme in low season.

Tourist tax?

The tourist tax is of 0.61€ (tariff 2015) per day and per person from 18 years. It must be paid on site and is not included in the tariffs. It is fully transferred to the town of Fréjus.

Means of payment?

Credit cards (Visa, Mastercard, Maestro) and cash are accepted on site.

How is the weather in April?

The month of April can be a very pleasant month, with fresh mornings and evenings, which will not prevent you from enjoying our heated pools.

Activities are organised during school holidays, for children aged between 7 and 12 years, from Monday to Friday in the afternoon, as well as for adults (boules tournaments, table tennis, darts, aquagym, card games...), and two entertainment nights per week at the restaurant.

The low season, from April to June, is ideal to visit our lovely region.

Activities?

We offer a wide range of activities organised by a team of 10 activity leaders. From 3 to 99 years, you'll find activities for all.

Do not hesitate to download an example of activity programme.

Shaded site?

This 15 ha site is set on a natural pine forest, offering shade on most of the pitches. However, some of the pitches may be sunny. We recommend you to inform us about your preference when you book.

Hilly site?

Our campsite is set on a hilly site, allowing each guest to have enough privacy. The camping part (150 camping pitches) is set in a flat area. The part with the mobile homes (300 rentals) is mostly built in terraces.

Type of customers on La Pierre verte ?

The campsite mainly welcomes families. The family spirit of the site is well-known. We welcome English, Dutch, German families... which makes it a cosmopolite site.

What kind of swimwear for men?

Bathing shorts and swimming trunks are allowed. Any other type of clothing is prohibited (T-shirt, bermuda, dress...).

Disabled access?

We inform our customers that our campsite may be difficult to access for disabled guests, because of its location.

However, we do our utmost to make the access for disabled as easy as possible: 2 disabled access sanitary blocks for the camping pitches, access ramp at the pool, adapted parking space at the bar restaurant. The site has also invested in a disabled access mobile home: the Cosmos mobile home, set by the water park.

Car parking ?

Each pitch offers enough space to park one car, free of charge. If you have two vehicles, an extra cost of 4€ per day will be invoiced to park it on the campsite.

In high season (July and August), vehicles must be parked on the night parking space, between midnight and 6 am.

Pets allowed?

Pets are allowed on site, with an extra cost of 4€ per pet and per day. Maximum 2 pets are allowed and dogs of the 1st and 2nd categories are prohibited. The vaccination booklet of your pet must be up-to-date and may be asked at any time. At the campsite reception, you'll find free dog waste bags.

In your absence, it is prohibited to leave your dog alone in the mobile home. Please make you're your pet does not cause any noise or trouble.

Internal rules?

Complying with the internal rules is compulsory on a public site. Staying on our campsite means you accept and comply with the internal rules. The internal rules are available on demand.

Environment?

Our campsite highlights an environmental policy since 2012. The site carries the Clef Verte label, which means you can be sure to stay on a preserved holiday site.

Security:

Is the site secure?

The campsite is secured. The gates at the entrance allow verifying entering cars. Only registered customers with a personal code have access.

From mid-June to mid-September, a team of security agents watches the site all night, making several rounds per night, to ensure the peace and quiet on site. In July and August, security is present 24 hrs per day, with controls at the entrance. The security phone can be reached 24 hrs per day. Wearing the campsite bracelet is compulsory. This bracelet will be handed to you on arrival and will identify you as a campsite guest.

In high season, traffic of motorised vehicles is prohibited on the campsite between midnight and 6 am.

A team of lifeguards is present 7 days per week at the pool, from the opening to the closure of the campsite.

Wearing the bracelet is compulsory?

Yes, wearing the campsite bracelet is compulsory. This bracelet will identify you as a campsite guest.

Are visitors accepted?

Your visitors are allowed on site. They must pay the extra cost for visitors to our agent at the campsite entrance; the tariff is of 5€ per person, from the age of 10 years and for a visit of more than one hour. Identity papers must be left at the reception. Visits are authorised between 9 am and 8 pm only. After 8 pm, access to the campsite will no longer be possible. We remind you that all customers, visitors included, must respect the internal rules of the campsite.

Is there a doctor or hospital nearby?

Contact details of the nearest doctor can be found in the welcome guide. The reception can also provide information about how and where to make an appointment. The doctor is located at 5 minutes driving from the campsite. He is available at his office from Monday to Friday from 8 am to 11 am without an appointment and from 3 pm to 6 pm with an appointment. The first aid station of the campsite can be found at the pool: our team of lifeguards may be of help in case of an emergency. The campsite is equipped with a defibrillator and oxygen. The hospital of Fréjus is located at 8km (15 min) from the campsite.

Services:

Is the pool heated?

Yes, the main pool surfaces 15m x 15m, and you'll find a leisure paddling pool and whirlpool. All basins are heated from the opening to the closure of the campsite.

Is there a water slide?

The water park is equipped with a 15 m long water slide (to use it, children must be able to swim!).

Is Wi-Fi paid?

The Wi-Fi connection is a paid service, knowing the entire site is covered with Wi-Fi. Tickets are for sale at the reception for 15€ per week and per user or for 25€ per week for three users.

Is barbecuing allowed?

Charcoal barbecues are strictly prohibited on site, by prefectural decree. Only electric « plancha » barbecues can be used to cook outside. We offer the hire of these barbecues for 35€ per week.

Activities for teens?

Teens will definitely enjoy our site, as it welcomes families with children and teens of all ages. They can easily meet at the various clubs, open every afternoon from Monday to Friday (in July and August). Most of the activities are organised by our own staff. In addition, each week a bus trip is organised: Aqualand, beach or tree climb adventure....

At night, they can meet at their own clubhouse at the entrance of the campsite, so that the peace of other guests will not be disturbed.

Hire a car, scooter or motorcycle?

If you are looking to hire a car, please ask the reception. Various partners are available and some even come to the campsite. The same service is available for scooters.

Hire a bicycle?

Next to the reception, you'll find out partner Riviera Evasion, offering various types of bicycles. Tariffs and information available at the reception. Reservation compulsory on the previous day.

Is there a launderette?

The campsite is equipped with a launderette, offering 5 washing machines (5 kg) as well as a tumble dryer. Tokens washing machine: 6€; token tumble dryer: 4€.

Can I borrow material?

With identity papers as a warranty, you can borrow a hairdryer, iron, electric adapters, board games, footballs and small sports materials (no extra cost).

Your mobile home:

Are sheets included?

Sheets are not included in the rent. You can hire sheets on site for 20€ per bed (cotton) or 10€ per bed (disposable). However, all the rentals are equipped with disposable undersheets, pillows and blankets.

Must I bring my towels?

Towels are not included in the rent. We offer the hire of towel sets for 10€ per person.

Heating?

All the rentals have heating in the living area.

Is there a parasol?

No, there are no parasols in the rentals. All the rentals are equipped with a covered terrace.

Are there extra charges?

Costs for water, electricity and household waste are included in the tariff of the rent.

Cleaning of the mobile home?

The cleaning is not included in the tariff and must be done by you, on the day you leave. However, we can offer you a cleaning service with extra cost of 80€ and with approval of the reception office.

Amperage?

The mobile homes are all equipped with a minimum of 10 amp = approx. 2000 Watt.
